In the Home

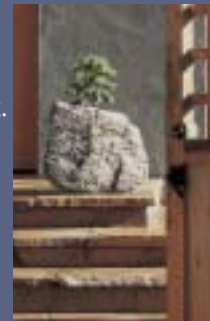

Featherock is at home in any architectural environment. Here are two views of a contemporary Japanese American residence. A sculpted Featherock planter with living conifer graces the interior, while a bonsai natural planter on the steps beckons the guest to enter.



Professional and amateur alike use the same common tools to rough out and detail Featherock sculpture: hammer, chisel, hand ax, rasp and wire brush. More advanced craftsmen may also use electric or pneumatic grinders and drills obtainable at hardware stores.

For subject matter your imagination will lead to art that identifies with its surroundings. Like the cover photo of the Greco-Roman architectural column emerging from a Featherock boulder. The classic "ruin" fits the scene. It adds storied romance to our verdant rustic garden.

Nature's plan for foliage is incomplete without stone. The impressionistic human form pictured above blends yet tames a tropical garden paradise.



At Poolside

Neptune reclaims an estate swimming pool with this graceful gray seal sunning on a charcoal Featherock boulder. She's teasing a floral topiary ball with her nose.

Waterscapes are one of nature's most attractive garden gifts. Featherock art brings life to these outdoor scenes through carved likenesses of water world creatures.

In and alongside fountains, ponds and pools they can play an active role in the water circus. Featherock sculpture can be easily drilled through in the rough stage with a length of pipe and hammer, or electric drill. Thread flexible plastic tubing and attach to a concealed recirculating pump for a continuous jet stream of water.



In the Courtyard

Mediterranea has given us the grapevine, olive and citrus trees. Warm gentle breezes here invite outdoor living and the intimacy of the private garden.

Ancient surrounds of brick and tile, concrete and stone are the perfect backdrop for arresting mythological wall sculpture like this Featherock gargoyle. The basin is a Featherock wall planter filled with trailing ivy.

Because Featherock is light in weight, these enduring weatherproof pieces can be mounted like a painting, using metal pegs and strong wire or chain link.
